FISHERY TYPE: COMMERCIAL

SPECIES: Green Sea Urchins

UPPER LIMIT: 25,000 pounds, cumulative treaty harvest

ON/OFF

RESERVATION: OFF

LEGAL GEAR: 1) Urchins shall be collected by hand or non-mechanical
"scoop"
2) DIVE SAFETY STANDARDS OUTLINED IN THE
PUYALLUP TRIBAL SHELLFISH CODE MUST BE
OBSERVED.

EFFECTIVE DATES: 10/13/2016 – 8/31/2017
OR UNTIL UPPER LIMIT IS TAKEN.

DAYS/HOURS: Seven days a week, half hour after sunrise - half
hour before sunset

RECORD KEEPING: 1) Catch shall be recorded on treaty fish receiving tickets.
2) Catch will be reported to Puyallup Shellfish within 48
hours of harvest.
3) Weekly harvest reports will be provided to affected parties
4) The harvester shall complete harvest logs for each harvest day.

OTHER: 1) minimum size limit 2.25 inches. No maximum size limit.
2) Harvest vessels may not have geoduck harvest water hoses on
board while participating in the Urchin harvest.

- 3) Skipper must notify Puyallup Tribal Enforcement Dispatch by 8:00 PM the evening before they plan to harvest.
